


Diverging Diamond Interchange





Reduced Conflict U-Turn (RCUT) Intersection








Continuous Green-T Intersection (CGT)







Thru-Cut Intersection



- ↑ Motorists on the side street may not go straight through the intersection. Depending on the location of the thru-cut, motorists will either:
 - turn right or left onto the major street and make a second turn at an adjacent side street OR
 - turn right onto the major street, make a u-turn at a median opening, and turn right onto the side street

Depending on their level of comfort, cyclists may navigate the intersection using vehicle or pedestrian paths

Pedestrians use marked crosswalks to safely cross the intersection



From the major street, navigate the intersection like at a conventional intersection

★ From the side street, turn right and left like at a conventional intersection
