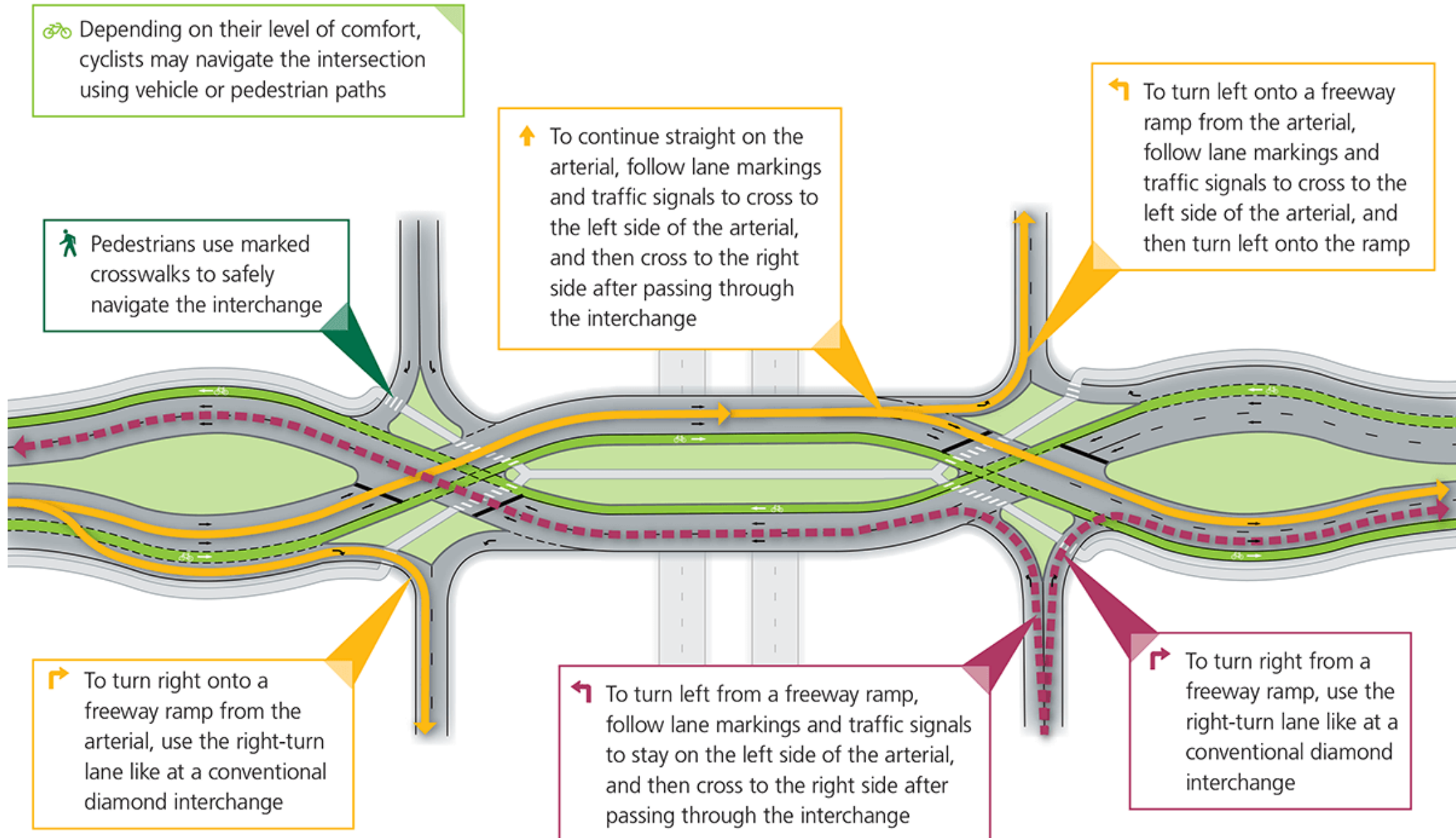


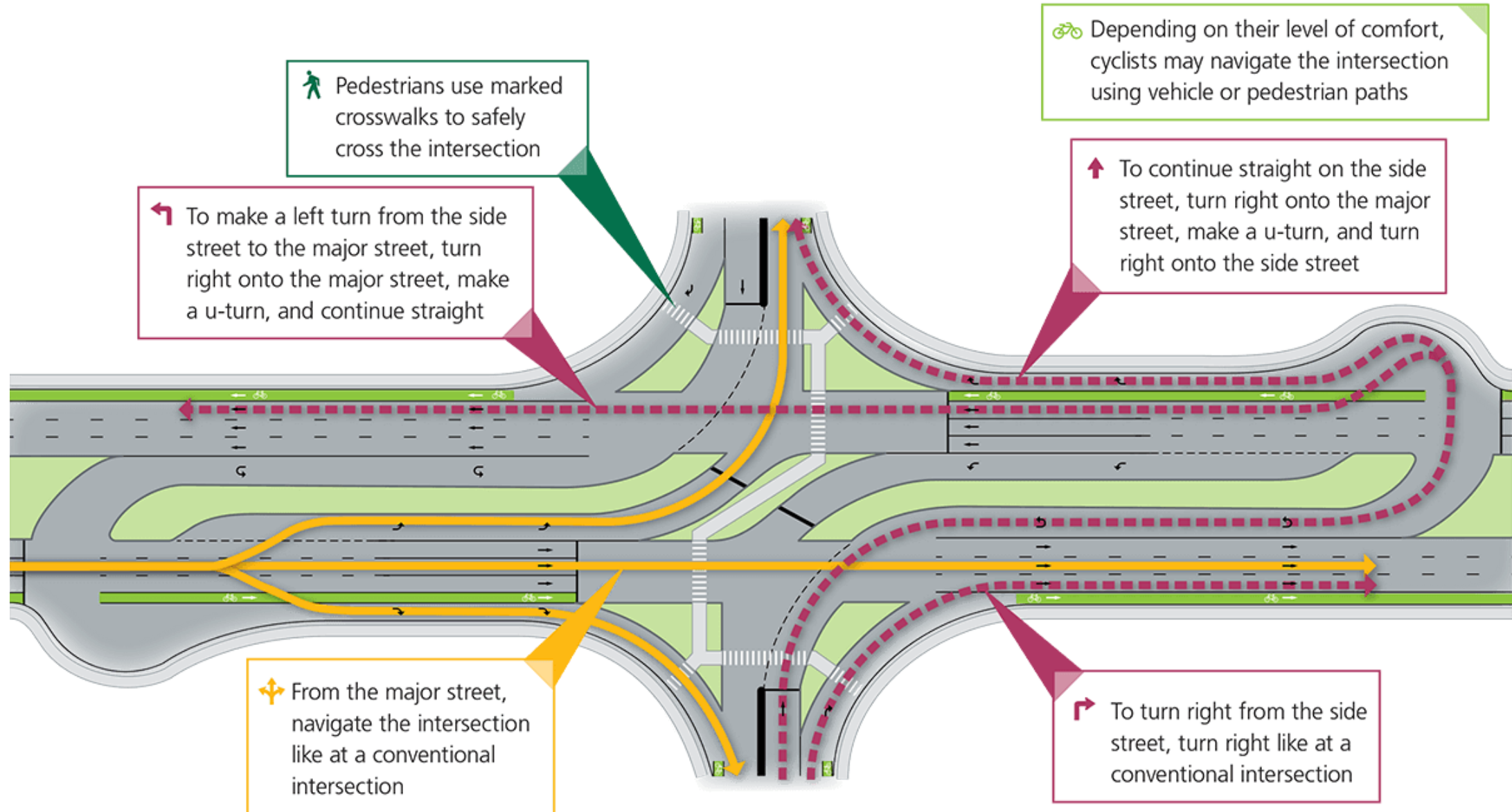


# Diverging Diamond Interchange



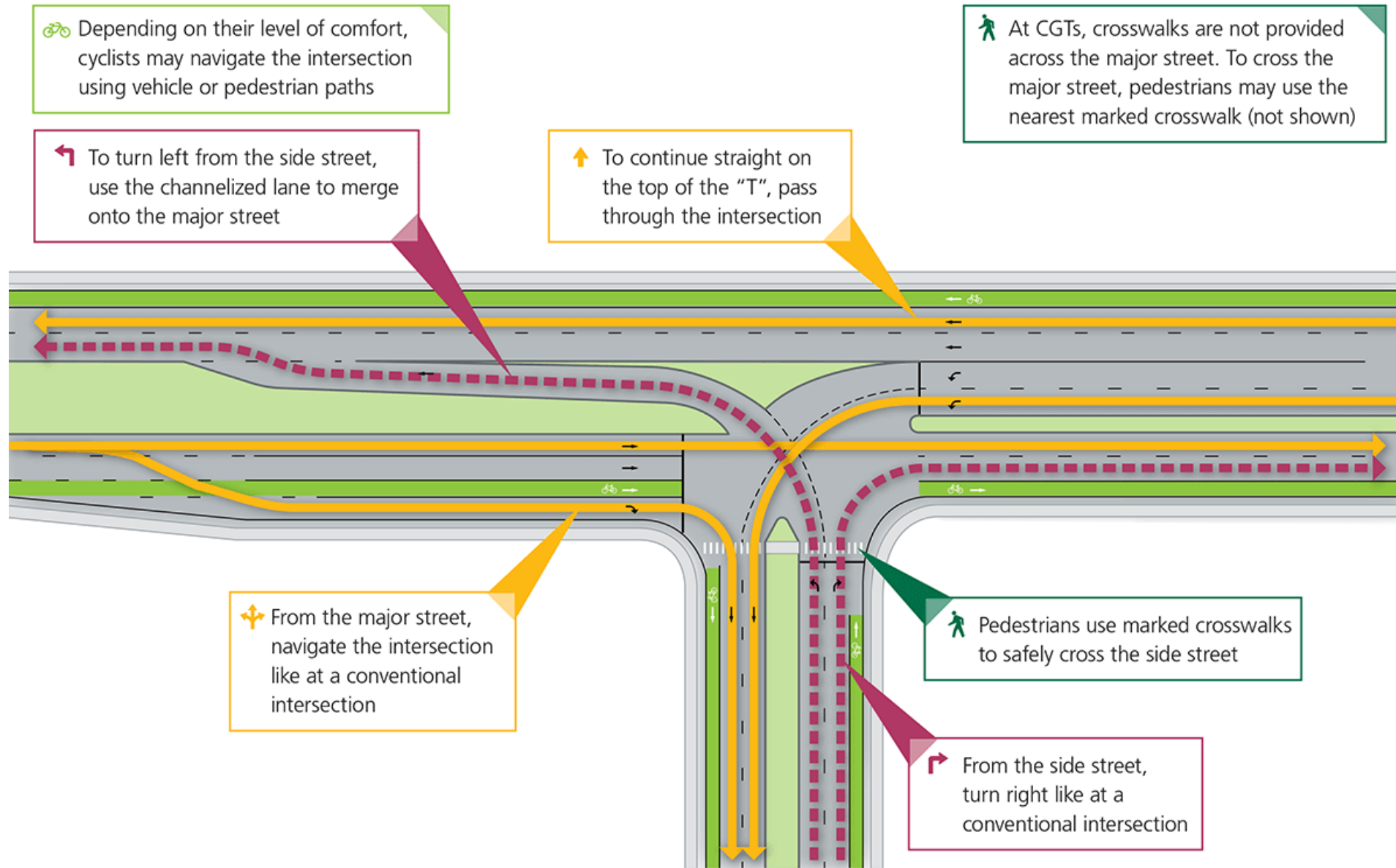


# Reduced Conflict U-Turn (RCUT) Intersection





# Continuous Green-T Intersection (CGT)







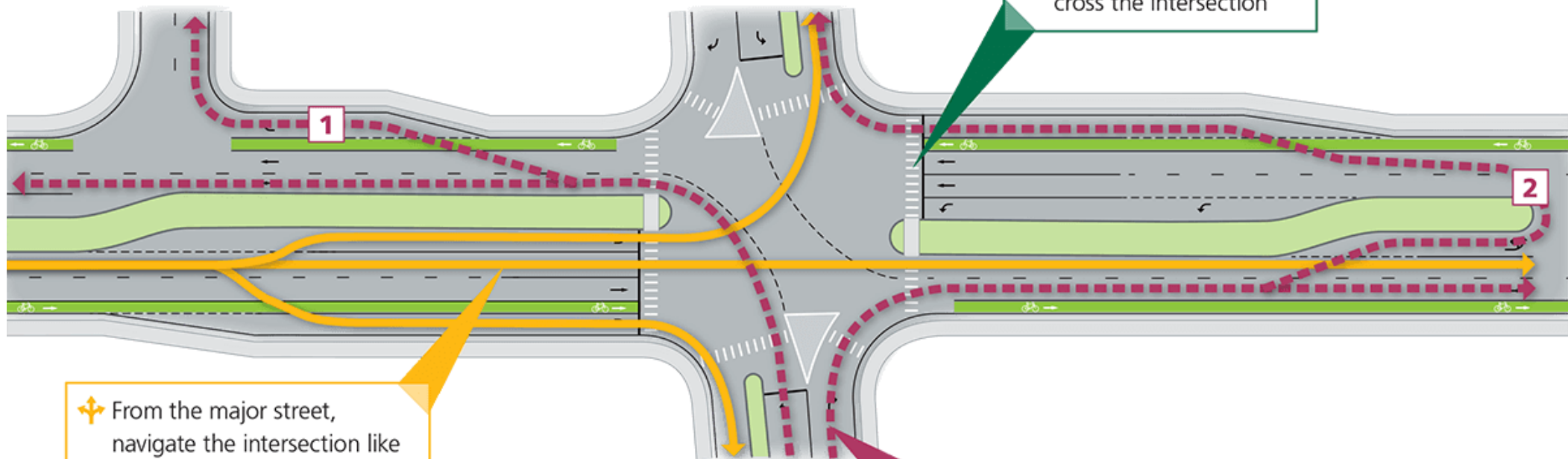
# Thru-Cut Intersection

↑ Motorists on the side street may not go straight through the intersection. Depending on the location of the thru-cut, motorists will either:

- 1 turn right or left onto the major street and make a second turn at an adjacent side street OR
- 2 turn right onto the major street, make a u-turn at a median opening, and turn right onto the side street

🚲 Depending on their level of comfort, cyclists may navigate the intersection using vehicle or pedestrian paths

🚶 Pedestrians use marked crosswalks to safely cross the intersection



✚ From the major street, navigate the intersection like at a conventional intersection

↩ From the side street, turn right and left like at a conventional intersection
